

COMPUTER EDUCATION

POLICY

To ensure that students have an opportunity to understand computer applications in society, develop skills in the use of computers as learning/instructional tools, and develop vocational skills which can lead to further training or employment opportunities, the Board through the superintendent and appropriate staff, shall provide a comprehensive computer education program.

PROCEDURE

Instruction, in-service and equipment will be available to provide:

- I. Computer literacy for all students.
 - A. Understanding of what computers are and how they evolved.
 - B. Appreciation of the capabilities and limitations of computers.
 - C. Knowledge regarding careers that are either directly or indirectly computer related.
 - D. Awareness of the implication of the computer to society.
- II. Computer literacy for all certificated staff members appropriate to their assignment.
- III. A district-wide coordinated computer education program which provides skill development in the use of computers as instructional tools and prepares students for computer related vocations or advanced training.
- IV. A staff which has the ability to deliver appropriate computer education at all instructional levels.
