

Maintenance of Facilities

POLICY

The Fitzgerald Board of Education is dedicated to providing an educational environment that is conducive to learning and meets the high standards of cleanliness and appearance that is expected by the community. To meet this expectation, all staff and individuals that use our facilities are required to follow these guidelines:

1. Bulletin boards, tack strips, and showcases are provided for the purpose of displaying student work and messages of importance. Everyone is required to use only these areas for display. The use of tape or other sticky substances may result in permanent damage to the surface of the wall or ceiling.
2. Floors throughout the facilities, such as in the gym, require special maintenance. Using tape or other sticky substances may result in permanent damage to the flooring.

If additional display areas are needed, individuals are asked to see the building principal who will arrange for bulletin boards or tack strips to be placed in the desired area.

If additional markings are required on the floor, individuals are asked to see the building principal who will make the appropriate arrangements to have these markings added to the floor.

The responsibility of maintaining our facilities belongs with each person that uses an area within the district. Everyone is required to follow these procedures in an effort to preserve the quality appearance of our buildings.
