

VOLUNTEERS

The Board of Education appreciates the time and effort of our volunteers in supporting the children of the district. The Board recognizes that programs and activities can be enhanced by the time our volunteers spend in schools and classrooms.

The Superintendent or designee shall be responsible for recruiting community volunteers, reviewing their capabilities and making appropriate placements. It is also the responsibility of the Superintendent or designee to:

- A. Inform each volunteer that s/he shall abide by all Board policies and district guidelines while on duty as a volunteer;
- B. Perform a criminal records check through the Michigan State Police ICHAT System on all volunteers who accompany and supervise students on field trips or who directly volunteer to work with students on a regular and continuous basis in accordance with the Michigan School Safety Legislation;
- C. Express appreciation for the volunteer's time and effort in assisting at school and throughout the district.
