Greetings Fitzgerald Community!

Thank You again for your support in passing the Non-Homestead Millage Renewal and the Sinking Fund Millage Renewal on the ballot earlier this month! These funds will support day to day operations and allow enhancements to educational programs across the district. Additional funds will be used to support building improvements including energy conservation initiatives, enhanced building security, updated classroom spaces, and technology upgrades that will continue to promote our shared mission of ***inspiring, empowering, and preparing today's learners to become tomorrow's leaders.***

We are really excited about the Chatterton Planetarium project! The project is currently under construction and is tracking for a March completion. A number of other projects are currently in the design phase, scheduled to bid early next year and start construction after school lets out in June, including district wide improvements to PA systems and security access systems, and a new roof for Mound Park Upper Elementary. Early design work is underway for building envelope improvements and offices in the Neigebaur Administration Building as well as a new Weight Room for the High School to be sited adjacent to the current athletic entrance; we are looking forward to both of these projects tracking to break ground this fall.
