As summer draws to a close and we prepare for the new school year, design and construction on bond work has continued at numerous Fitzgerald Public Schools buildings.

Across the District, installation of digital monument signs and site wayfinding signage is complete. Monument signage at each school identifies the building and features an LED message board to relay information and announcements to the community. Wayfinding signage aids visitors and emergency responders with site navigation. The consistent design of the signage between schools helps to create a unified campus feel throughout the District.



Recently completed work at Schofield Elementary includes new drywall, paint, and stage floor stain.

Inside the building, work has continued on the multi-purpose room stage renovations with new paint and refinished wood stage floor. Upcoming work on the stage includes new lighting, acoustic panels, and a new stage curtain. Demolition of the stage at Neigebaur is also underway.

Renovations to the Mound Park Main Office are complete and include a new welcome desk and new windows that increase visibility between office staff and visitors entering / exiting the building. Finally, interior improvements at Westview are nearing completion.

Future bond work includes ground breaking and construction of the Fitzgerald High School Weight Room Addition; we look forward to being able to share this facility with our students and community. Thank you Fitzgerald community for your continued support!
