We are excited to announce that the Fitzgerald High School Weight Room Addition broke ground in early September and has been making steady progress. The addition will be located at the Northeast Entrance off of Bart Avenue and includes new facilities for exercise and weight lifting for Fitzgerald High School's athletic teams, as well as an expanded lobby space.

At Mound Park Elementary, site improvements concluded with fresh sod and new plantings at the Main Building Entrance. Along with the recently completed new paving and monument sign, the landscaping will provide a welcoming impression to both students and visitors. Improvements are also underway at Neigebaur and include new metal panels at window openings, exterior masonry repair and reconstruction, and interior renovations.
