## ADMISSION OF NONRESIDENT PUPILS; DETERMINATION OF TUITION RATES; COLLECTION OF TUITION; LIMITATIONS OF TUITION

The Board Of Education may admit nonresident pupils to the schools of the district who are not entitled to receive a free, public education in this District and whose enrollment has been approved by the Board.

The board shall determine the rates of tuition of the nonresident pupils and shall collect the tuition. MCL 380.1401

Tuition rates shall be determined and approved annually by the Board and shall represent the cost per student membership within the limits established by law. Rates will be available before the beginning of the school year or before the student's attendance commences. Charges shall be the maximum permitted by law.

The Superintendent will establish an administrative guideline for the collection and limitations of tuition costs.
