EPINEPHRINE AUTO-INJECTORS POLICY

Students who are prescribed epinephrine to treat anaphylaxis shall be allowed to self-possess and self-administer the medication if they meet the conditions as stated in the Medication Policy.

Commencing with the 2014-15 school year, each school in the District shall have at least two (2) epinephrine auto-injectors (Epi-Pens) available at the school site. It shall be the responsibility of the Maintenance/Custodial Supervisor to be sure that the supply of Epi-Pens is maintained at the appropriate level and they have not expired. The Maintenance/Custodial Supervisor shall also be responsible for coordinating the training of District employees to administer Epi-Pen injections and to maintain the list of employees authorized to administer such injections.
