<b>Proposed changes to plan:</b>	<p>Return to In Person Learning for PK-12 starting on November 9, 2020.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Elementary Parents (Grades PK-5) will have the option to send students to school for five full days of instruction or continue with virtual learning.</li> <li>Secondary Parents (Grades 6-12) will have the option to send students to school in a hybrid model for two full days of instruction per week, with three days of virtual instruction. Parents will also have the option to continue with five full days of virtual learning instruction.</li> </ul>
