Message from the Superintendent

A Year of Great Change ~

As we close the 19/20 school year, it is a good time to reflect on the past and share a few final thoughts. Wow, what a year!



We would never have imagined that a global pandemic would have crossed our paths and changed our lives forever. We never planned for face-to-face instruction being suspended or having to provide online or paper/pencil instruction for 3.5 months of the school year. The Fitzgerald staff worked hard and around the clock to find creative and unique ways to make connections with our students and families. The staff yearned to provide ongoing stability during a time of such uncertainty.

I want to end this year by honoring all of OUR HEROES ~ The Fitzgerald Staff who went above and beyond and did everything they could to keep their students and parents informed and educated. We have witnessed educators from preK through high school scramble to provide distance learning alternatives where possible - with the understanding that none of it can replace the power of a face-to-face education. The district distributed nearly 1,000 chromebooks to support online/at home learning. The custodians, administrators, bus drivers and secretaries who have been supporting and providing services to our families during this entire time of closure. Our food service workers, a team of dedicated individuals employed through Aramark, prepared and distributed over 132,000 meals since March. The Fitzgerald Students who were forced to change their method of learning - having to endure no interactions with staff, their peers or friends. On a daily basis, over 90% of our students stayed connected and completed assignments given to them by their teachers. The Fitzgerald Parents who were forced into becoming their child's teacher, mentor and educator. Doing all of this while juggling the uncertainty of the economy, job loss and everything else that came along with a pandemic crisis. And to the Class of 2020 who missed out on traditional milestones such as prom and a formal graduation. Your class has made history - you will forever be known as the most resilient Fitzgerald graduating class. Oprah Winfrey stated it so well, "Even though there may not be pomp because of our circumstances, never has a graduating class been called to step into the future with more purpose, vision, passion, and energy and hope."

Let us all be reminded that as we look into the future, there soon will be a day where learning will take place in a classroom with skilled teachers, supportive staff, eager minds, laughing students and the buzz of what assignments are due and when. Continue to have hope that the strength of our community will overcome these troubling times and resume back to a new normal. You will be informed during the summer of the 20/21 school year plans for reopening.

I have never been more proud to be leading such a wonderful team of educators and staff. However, it is with mixed emotion that I share my news. I will be retiring at the end of August after 30+ years in education. I grew up in the Fitzgerald district and was lucky to obtain my first teaching job at Mound Park. I have served students, parents and staff in all of our buildings and at each level. Fitzgerald is a wonderful community and should continue to celebrate their successes and small community charm. I plan to work with the Board of Education to find a suitable replacement and help with the transition of the new superintendent. I will treasure the memories, friendships and positive relationships that I have developed over the years. I will always hold the district close to my heart and wish the best for its success. Once a Spartan, always a Spartan!

Free Head Start & GSRP Preschool

Kindergarten Screening

All students new to the district that are enrolling in kindergarten including Young 5's, will meet with a kindergarten teacher either August 18 or August 19 to be screened for kindergarten readiness. The 20 minute screening process will provide the teacher with information about placement for your child. The screening will address social/emotional development, communication and literacy skills, fine motor development and number knowledge. The screening appointments will be set up in June for those already registered and at the time of enrollment for those enrolling in the summer.

We are excited to be offering a Young 5's program for students who will be five years of age between July 1 and December 1. The Young 5's program is a bridge between Preschool and Kindergarten providing young learners the opportunity to learn and grow in an environment that is tailored to meet their academic and social needs. Kindergarten standards and curriculum have changed over the years and many skills that were taught in First Grade are now expected in Kindergarten. The students did a wonderful job embracing their roles and working to be responsible role models for their classmates. Mound Park staff are looking forward to building on this program next year with even more leadership roles available for students.

The After School Program is a Huge Success at Westview!

The Westview After School Enrichment Program in its second year continues to prove to be a tremendous success in offering our students weekly opportunities to learn fun new skills. The program meets weekly for an hour after school and allows interested students to participate in a variety of different program topics they might not have experienced before. Students work together with their peers and teachers to learn new things and enjoy a snack during the program.



Popular sessions that students have been able to choose from include: tap dancing, learning American Sign Language, artistic jewelry making, STEM technology, karate, learning how to speak Spanish, yoga, Zumba, understanding the science of making slime, cheerleading, and football training camp. On average, 75-100 students attend each session. The smiles on students' faces and parent positive comments regarding the program also indicate that the program is a worthwhile addition to Westview. The After School Enrichment Program is supported by federal grant funds, staff who volunteer to chaperone each session, community partners, and Fitzgerald High School clubs and sports teams who assist in leading the program for our students. We look forward to continuing to offer this exciting program in the future.

Students enjoyed working in teams to experiment and problem solving with different littleBits components to build a Star Wars style bot and then their own bots that were operational through computer based commands. 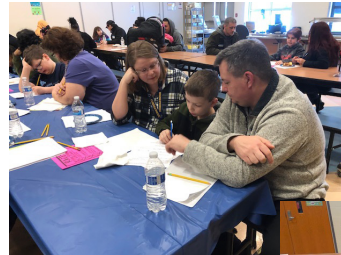


Third Grade M-Step Donut Party

This fun and family oriented activity allowed students to work with their parents as they practiced reading and writing skills needed for the MSTEP state assessment.

Each year 3rd graders across the state take the state MSTEP Assessment in Reading and Mathematics. The donut party was a wonderful way for parents to learn more about the format of the MSTEP test and the type of reading and writing students are expected to do on the state test.

During the donut party students were able to interview their parents regarding a family tradition, read articles about family traditions in other parts of the world, and then compose an essay about their information. Our student/parent teams did a wonderful job creating detailed writing using the strategies shared during the session.
