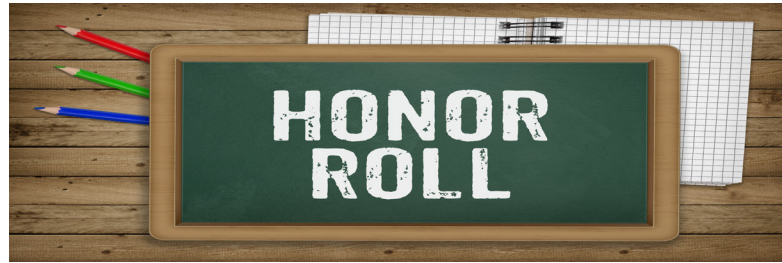

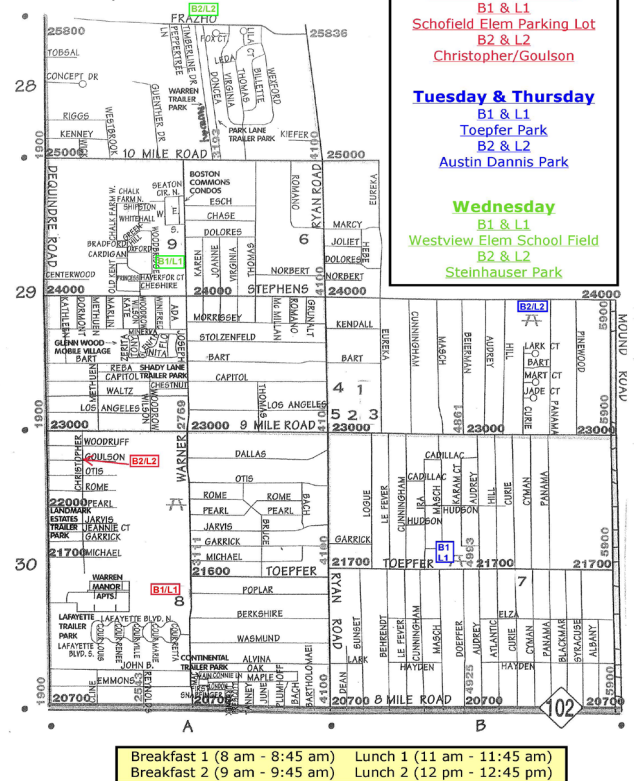

Fitzgerald Public Schools District Map



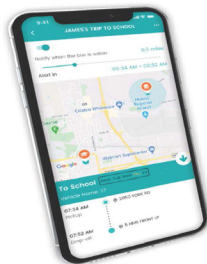

The Edulog Parent Portal is a self-service app that allows you to track your child's assigned transportation from his or her school. Know what routes and vehicles have been assigned to your child, complete with planned pickup and drop off locations and times. Track in real time your child's bus's position. Know when to send your child to the bus stop to avoid waiting in bad weather. Configure notifications to alert you when your child's bus is nearing pickup or drop off.

Free Head Start & GSRP Preschool

Federally funded Head Start for three and four year olds and State funded Great Start Readiness Program (GSRP) for eligible four year olds are two preschool programs available at Schofield Early Childhood Center. Children enrolling in GSRP must be 4 years old by September 1, 2021. Children born between September 2 - December 1, 2021 will be placed on the waiting list and may be enrolled in the fall. Our GSRP program is designed to promote growth in language, social/emotional development, literacy, math, fine motor, gross motor and self-help skills. We have full and half day sessions available. 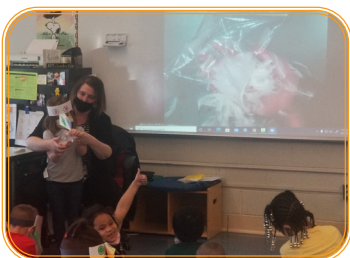


Schofield Offers Young 5's Program

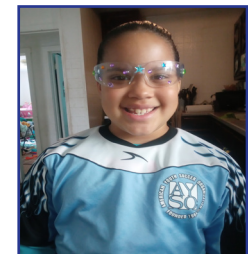
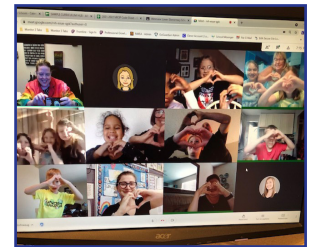
