Message from the Superintendent

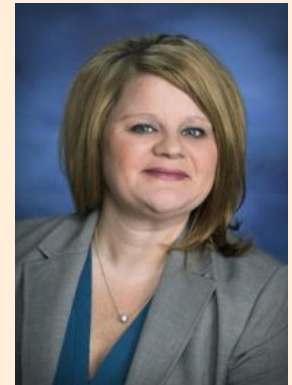

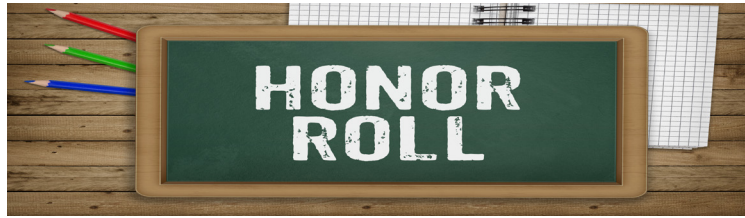

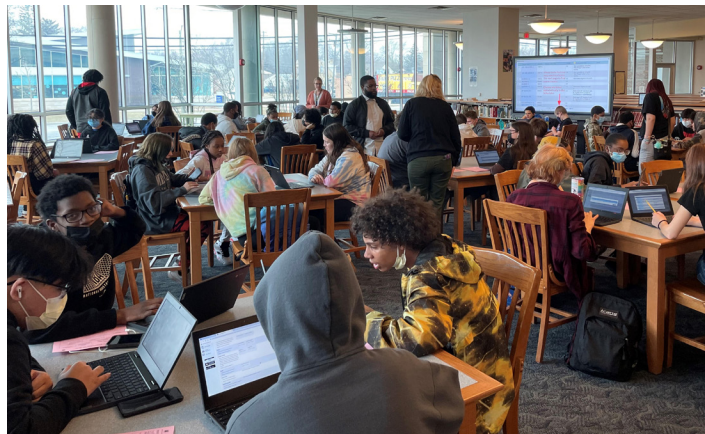
