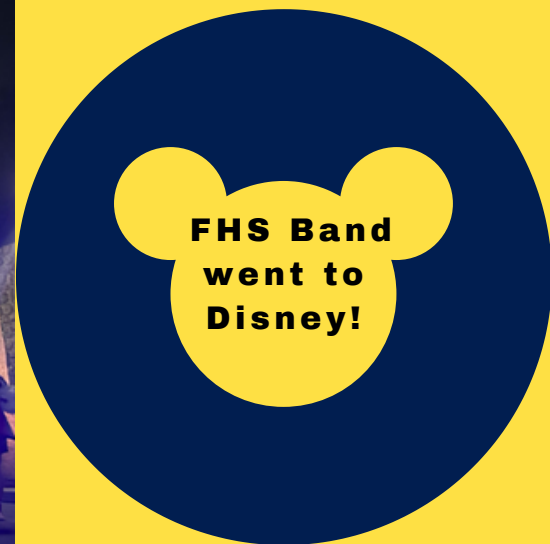

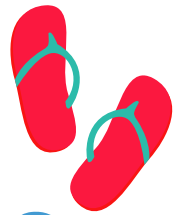

# Busing Updates

The Fitzgerald Public Schools Transportation department is grateful for all the families who have downloaded and use the Edulog Parent Portal app! This school year our drivers have transported over 620 students to/from school, taken many class field trips, bused our outstanding student athletes to/from competitions and logged almost 100,000 miles safely!

Emails will be sent in early August to families who are eligible for busing in the 2023-2024 school year. All parents of busing students must request transportation annually. If your student is eligible and requires a bus to/from school, please complete the Transportation Request portion of the Edulog Parent Portal app at <https://fitz.k12.mi.us/edulog-parent-portal/>. Please contact your child's school to update any contact information. If you do not submit a request, your student will not be eligible to receive transportation.

## Great Start Readiness Program

Schofield Early Childhood Center is excited to continue our partnership with the Great Start Readiness Program (GSRP) for eligible four year olds. Children enrolling in GSRP must be 4 years old by September 1, 2023. Children born between September 2 - December 1 will be placed on the waiting list and may be enrolled in the fall. Our GSRP program is designed to promote growth in language, social/emotional development, literacy, math, fine motor, gross motor and self-help skills. We have full and half day sessions available. The 20 minute screening process will provide the school team with information about placement for your child. It will address social/emotional development, communication and literacy skills, fine motor development and number knowledge. Appointments will be set up at the time of registration.

## Westview Family Science Night - April 19, 2023

Westview's Family Science Night was an exciting hands-on experience for our families who had a blast participating in over ten different hands-on learning stations! Students and their parents explored ten different types of science based stations with activities ranging from Earth science to chemistry. Students created Goo which changes from a soft solid to a liquid and back again, created electrical circuits to make fans and robots, and even engaged in making their very own ice cream using the power of Chemistry. Families had a lot of fun competing to see who could create a tin foil boat that could hold the most amount of weight and were in awe as they used cabbage juice to determine the pH of everyday household liquids. Families created bubbles using straws and bubble solution to test viscosity and enjoyed a tasty meal before heading home with two awesome science books to add to their at home reading library.



## Westview 2nd Grade Field Trip

On Friday, April 14, 2023 the 2nd graders at Westview Elementary went to Warren Community Center for an annual author presentation hosted by the Warren Public Library. The 2023 author our students got to meet and learn about was Nancy Shaw.

Ms. Shaw is a local author who attended University of Michigan and lives in the Ann Arbor area. She shared how she

came up with ideas for her children's books. She is most known for her book "Jeep in Sheep" and all the books in the Sheep series.

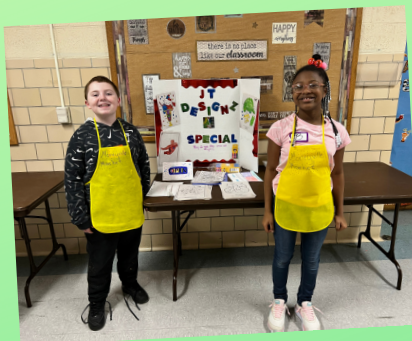




# Mound Park Upper Elementary School

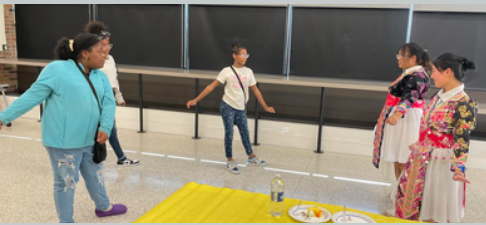


## Electrical Safety

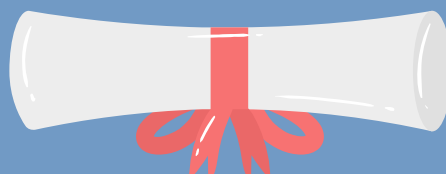
