MEDICAL EXAMINATIONS, STUDENTS

<u>POLICY</u>

A student whose behavior indicates that presence in a particular class is questionable on the basis of possible personal harm to self or to other classroom members, may be requested to present a statement from a qualified medical doctor confirming that the student's continued presence in the class is justified from a medical standpoint.

PROCEDURE

- 1. Concerns over a student's welfare shall be expressed to the building principal in writing.
- 2. The building principal shall enlist the assistance of supportive staff, i.e., special education, counselors, etc., to observe and/or investigate.
- 3. If the investigation indicates the need for medical evaluation, the school will notify the parents.
