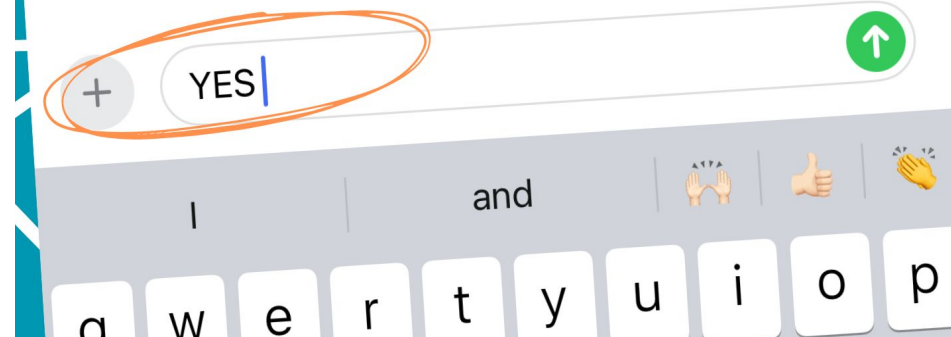

Security Issue	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>A threat has been made to a building.</li> <li>A community safety issue that affects one or more of our buildings</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>These calls are made in the event that a threat has been made to a school.</li> <li>If a situation around a school makes it unsafe for students to arrive or leave the building.</li> </ul> <p>In these cases, Fitzgerald works closely with the Warren Police Department to determine what steps need to be taken to ensure the safety of everyone.</p>

- 1 M-STEP** | The M-STEP test is a computer test required by the Michigan Department of Education. The test provides important information about your child's progress in reading and mathematics.
- 2 SCHEDULE** | Students will begin the test on April 17-18 & 24-25, 2024 from 8:20am - 11:00am. Students can take breaks during the tests and will have extra time in the afternoon if needed.
- 3 LOCATION** | All 3rd graders will test in classrooms or small groups in person at Westview Elementary School.
- 4 PREPARE** | All students will practice sample M-STEP questions, practice using the testing tools, review the vocabulary words they may see on the test, and discuss ways they can do their best if they don't know the answer.
- 5 INCENTIVES** | All students who are on time for both testing days and give their best effort on the test will be entered into a raffle drawing to win prizes!
- 6 RESULTS** | A copy of your students M-STEP scores will be mailed home during the summer months.

We want to share with you the reasons why we close buildings, how the decision is made and what terms we use so that you can understand what is happening at that time. Our goal is always to communicate and share all the information that we can so that you can make informed decisions for your family.

#### Types of School Closing:

Type	Why?	How is this decision made?
Inclement Weather	Unsafe travel to or from school	Weather reports, road conditions, and students travel methods are all consulted when we plan for a closure due to weather. We need to make sure that it is safe for our students to get to and/or from school.
Building Issue	Building is not able to have students in attendance due to a issue with a building system	These calls are made when there is an issue preventing the building from having students in attendance. This could be power outages, water main breaks, or other events that make the building unuseable for the day.
Security Issue	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>A threat has been made to a building.</li> <li>A community safety issue that affects one or more of our buildings</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>These calls are made in the event that a threat has been made to a school.</li> <li>If a situation around a school makes it unsafe for students to arrive or leave the building.</li> </ul> <p>In these cases, Fitzgerald works closely with the Warren Police Department to determine what steps need to be taken to ensure the safety of everyone.</p>

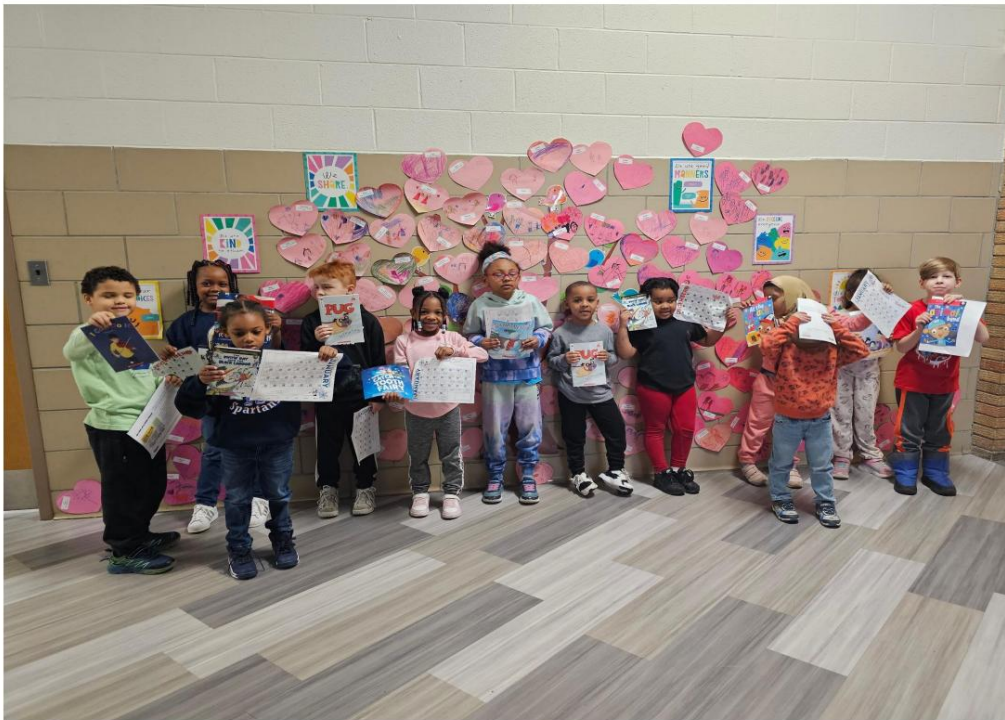

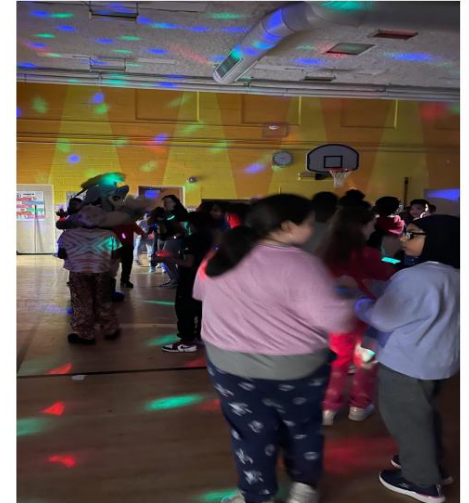

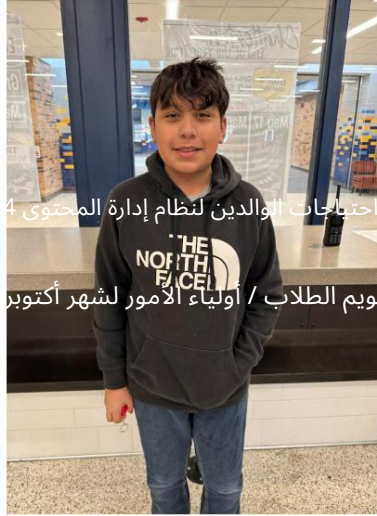

We want to share with you the reasons why we close buildings, how the decision is made and what terms we use so that you can understand what is happening at that time. Our goal is always to communicate and share all the information that we can so that you can make informed decisions for your family.

#### Types of School Closing:

Type	Why?	How is this decision made?
Inclement Weather	Unsafe travel to or from school	Weather reports, road conditions, and students travel methods are all consulted when we plan for a closure due to weather. We need to make sure that it is safe for our students to get to and/or from school.
Building Issue	Building is not able to have students in attendance due to a issue with a building system	These calls are made when there is an issue preventing the building from having students in attendance. This could be power outages, water main breaks, or other events that make the building unuseable for the day.
Security Issue	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>A threat has been made to a building.</li> <li>A community safety issue that affects one or more of our buildings</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>These calls are made in the event that a threat has been made to a school.</li> <li>If a situation around a school makes it unsafe for students to arrive or leave the building.</li> </ul> <p>In these cases, Fitzgerald works closely with the Warren Police Department to determine what steps need to be taken to ensure the safety of everyone.</p>

- 6 RESULTS** | A copy of your students M-STEP scores will be mailed home during the summer months.

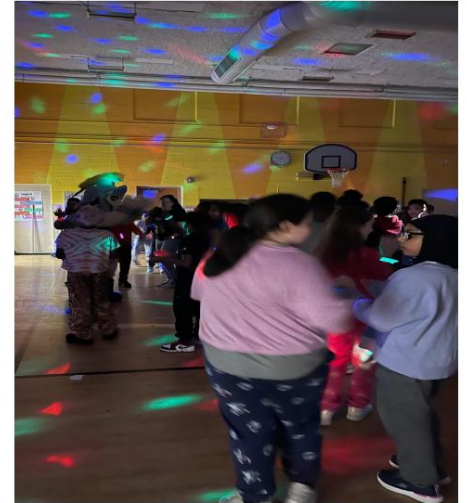

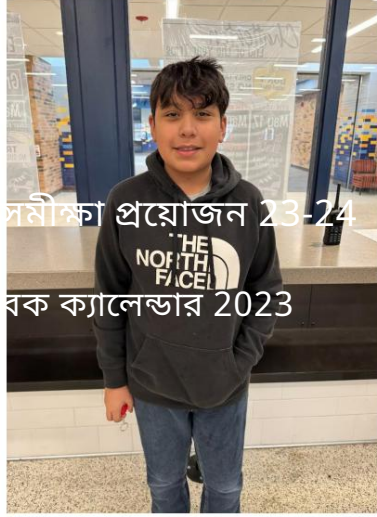
