RESIDENCY: NON-RESIDENT STUDENT RE-ENROLLMENT POLICY

POLICY

The Board of Education of this district recognizes that, pursuant to MCL 389.1606(4)(b), a district may count a non-resident student in membership with the approval of the student's district of residence.

PROCEDURE

In recognizing such, it shall become the policy of this district to grant a request for reenrollment from non-resident student upon satisfaction of the following conditions:

- A. The student shall have previously and continuously attended Fitzgerald Public Schools for the immediate past five (5) school years. If the student has siblings who otherwise meet the conditions set forth in Paragraphs B and C, but who, due to age, cannot meet this five (5) year requirement, the district may permit the enrollment of the sibling(s), in its discretion, and subject to available openings, etc.
- B. The student shall have been in good standing for the entire duration of his/her scholastic history regardless of the building/district that he/she attended, and shall not have been suspended, expelled, or subject to pending disciplinary action regardless of the building/district that he/she attended.
- C. The student shall obtain a written release from the Superintendent of the student's current district of residence, or said Superintendent's designee, and file this release with Fitzgerald Public Schools.
- D. Upon review and satisfaction of the conditions set forth in Paragraphs A, B, and C, the Fitzgerald Public Schools' Superintendent, or his/her designee, may recommend the admission and enrollment of the student(s) to the Board of Education pursuant to this policy.

Upon satisfaction of the above-stated conditions, Fitzgerald Public Schools shall grant the requesting student(s) membership in Fitzgerald Public Schools. This policy shall not conflict with the provisions of the State School Aid Act or other policies of the District.
