TENURE STATUS OF PERSONNEL

Professional staff members covered by the Michigan Teachers' Tenure Act shall acquire tenure in accordance with the Michigan Teachers Tenure Act (M.C.L. 38.71 et. seq.).

In accordance with the time periods specified in the Act, the Superintendent shall make recommendations to the Board regarding whether probationary employees covered by the Act should be permitted to acquire tenure. These recommendations shall be acted upon by the Board.

- Administrators shall not be entitled to acquire tenure in administrative positions.
 Therefore, all contracts of employment with administrators shall contain the following language: "Tenure in any administrative or non classroom position is denied."
- 2. Teachers who accept administrative positions or any other position which provides for pay beyond the teaching salary schedule will retain their tenure status as classroom teachers only.
- 3. Administrators who have acquired tenure in the past shall retain only that tenure status, regardless of advancement in position.
