## **TESTING OUT**

Michigan law provides opportunities for high school students to demonstrate content mastery of a particular course by successfully completing and scoring well on a single test or series of tests created by the subject area department. These tests will be given twice each school year at the high school. Students are required to satisfy the Michigan Merit Curriculum (MMC). This legislation mandates that these students receive high school graduation credit for "testing out" of a course at a level of content mastery determined by the subject area department. Dates for application window can be found on the Fitzgerald High School Website.

## **CONTENT MASTERY**

The following are levels of content mastery for testing out:

- **Scores below 77%** will not demonstrate proficiency and students will be required to take the course for high school graduation credit.
- Scores 77% or higher will demonstrate content mastery of the course and students will be given both Fitzgerald High School and Michigan Merit Curriculum credit for that course.
