PARENTAL PARTICIPATION IN TITLE I PROGRAMS POLICY

The Fitzgerald Public School's Board of Education understands that parent involvement is a key component of federal Title I programs. In order to help build a partnership between home and school for purposes of Title I, Fitzgerald Public Schools will:

- 1. Inform parents of the program, the reasons for their children's participation and the specific instructional objectives;
- 2. Support parents to work with their children to attain instructional objectives;
- 3. Train teachers and other staff involved in Title I programs to work effectively with the parents of participating students;
- 4. Provide feedback to parents on a regular basis;
- 5. Provide opportunities for parents to provide input into the design, operation and evaluation of the Title I programming; and
- 6. Provide opportunities for parents who lack literacy skills or whose native language is not English, to provide input.

The Superintendent, or designee, will develop and implement regulations that are compliant with Title I. The regulations shall support the above principles and actions and also to assure that the services provided with state and local funds in Title I schools are comparable to those provided in non-Title I schools within the District.
